CAMP/SUMMER PROGRAMS

- Over 2,700 children attended summer camp
- 62% of children attending camp received some form of financial assistance

• 252 Mentoring, Kidz Konnect, Summer Leaders participants

CHILDCARE

- OCY served 4,157 children daily within our 46 childcare sights
- 57% of the families in our childcare programs received financial assistance



ADDRESSING FOOD INSECURITY IN OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY

- 5,000 meals per week have been distributed to kids and families in need since mid-March of 2020.
- In October 2020, 50,000 lbs of food was distributed (the equivalent of one week of staple food items for 1,500 families) in partnership with the USDA's Farmers to Families program.
- During the 2020 holiday season, Old Colony Y Branches collected and distributed more than 2,000 lbs of food and other essential items throughout our region.
