WHAT TO PACK

Preparing for camp can seem daunting but we compiled a list of must haves and some tips for the summer. Write your name on everything and make sure to send in your child's updated physical and immunizations. **Bring These Items Everyday:** Closed toed shoes, water bottle with water, bathing suit & towel, sunscreen, and bug spray. **Items not Permitted:** Valuable items, electronics, trading cards, toys, candy, or weapons (real or fake)

SWIMMING

While at Camp, your child will be participating in water fun and safety. This will be the time for the children to cool down throughout their camp days and learn more about being safe in the water! Children younger than 8 years old will be required to wear a life jacket while participating in all water activities. Children 8+ will be given the option to take a swim test to test out of wearing a life jacket during swim time and have the option to swim in the deep end, but will still be required to wear a life jacket during all other water activities.

HOT/ RAINY DAY

In the case of thunder, lightning and torrential downpours, all campers are brought inside. In the case of light rain or high heat, we try to continue activities outdoors utilizing the pavilion and tent areas. In high heat we will incorporate more water activities during the day, and stay in the shade to help the campers keep cool.

*Member Fee: Your child(ren) must be on a family membership with any Old Colony YMCA location at time of registration and through their attendance at camp to receive member pricing. No transportation on week 1. Counselor-In-Training camp runs for two different sessions; from Week 2-5 as well as Week 6-9.

*Camp Payments: A \$60 per week deposit is due at time of registration. The remaining camp tuition must be paid in full by June 15th, 2025. Families can choose to pay in full at time of registration, or in monthly installments (Installment Dates are: March 10th, April 10th, May 10th and June 10th). If you enroll after one of the installment dates, payments for the missed installments are due at time of registration.

This camp must comply with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and be licensed by the local board of health. Per Massachusetts law, parents may at any time request copies of background check, health care and discipline policies as well as procedures for filing grievances by contacting our camp office.
